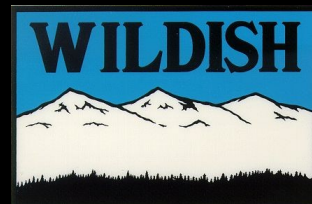

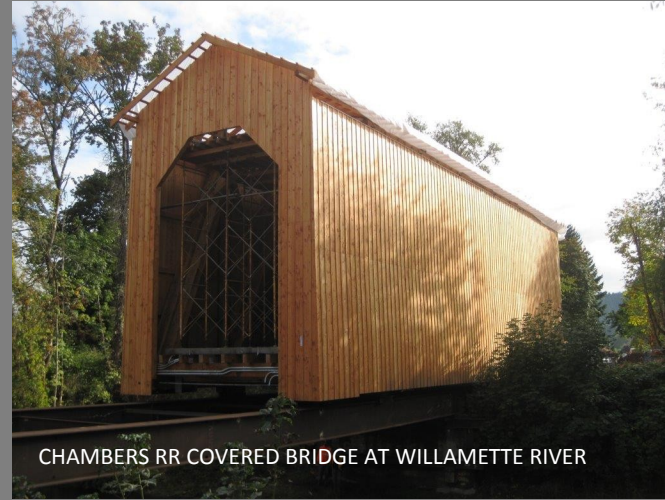
The Oregon City Arch Bridge between West Linn & Oregon City is the only thru arch steel bridge covered in shotcrete like this in the U.S. Work included extensive removal and replacement of shotcrete, deteriorated steel members, concrete bridge rails, light baluster posts and HPC deck overlay. Performing this kind of historical bridge restoration is dangerous work. But we feel our years of experiences and technically sound management team bring a level of competence like no other. I-84 AT FIFTEEN MILE



This 800LF suspension bridge spans across the McKenzie River and is one tenth the length of the Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco. It connects our mining operation on the north side of the river to our processing facility on the south side using a highly efficient conveyor belt to carry material directly to our gravel processing facility. This eliminates the need for raw materials to be transported by truck reducing traffic congestion on public highways.

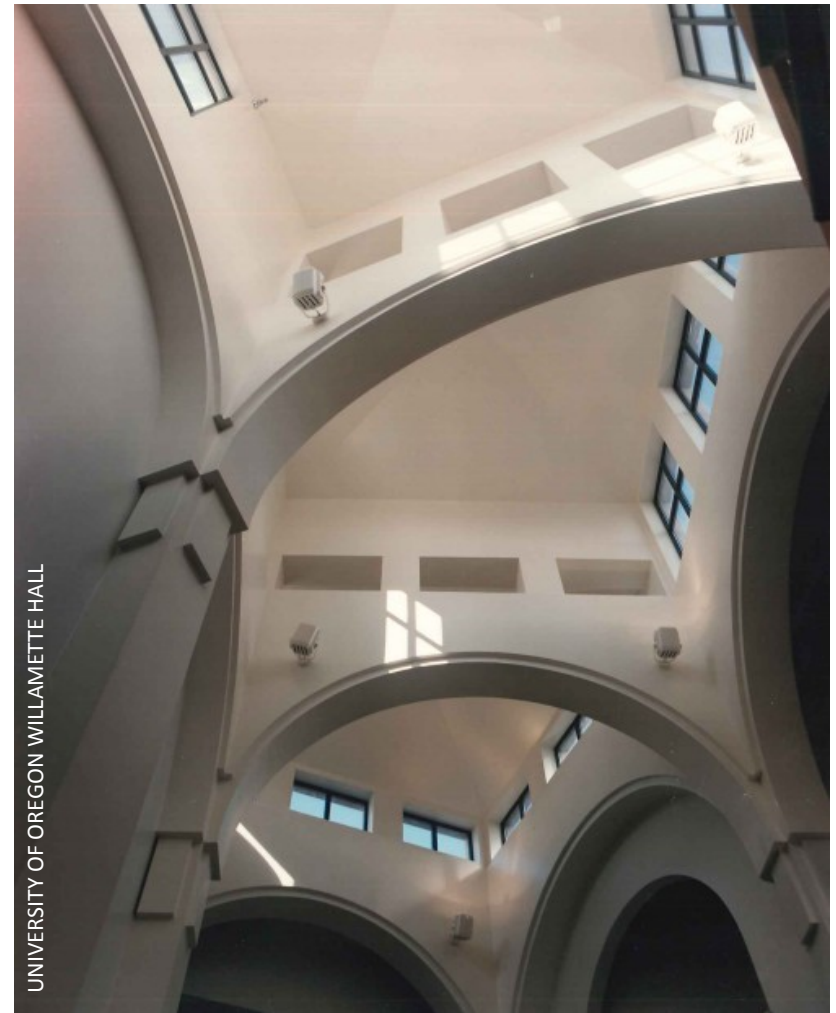
